Authors were invited by way of the CASEA newsletter to submit recent book publications. From this invitation, eleven books came forward, ten of which will be included in this year's book launch. One book was submitted by a non-CASEA member who declined membership at this time.

There are two authors (Ben Levin & Carolyn Shields) with multiple submissions, so although we have ten submissions, we have eight authors. One set of authors (Lyn Sharratt & Michael Fullan) is unable to attend, and have requested Bev Freedman to speak on behalf of their book.

Due to the large number of submissions, we have altered the format from 2011. Authors were asked to vote on an option as to whether they would prefer five minutes to speak about their book to the whole audience, or whether they would prefer to be in two groups, with ten minutes per book, but to only half the audience. All eight authors voted for five minutes to the whole group.

The CASEA book launch will take place on May 28, from 3:00-4:15 at the Grad Pub on Waterloo campus. Each book is allotted a five minute spot during which its author(s) can introduce the book and give any information they see fit. With ten books, this should take 50 minutes, leaving us 25 minutes of chat and mingle time with the authors. We anticipate providing snacks and one drink ticket per attendee, although this has yet to be confirmed.
