

**Vice President's Report to the Annual General Meeting
Canadian Association for the Study of Educational Administration (CASEA)
Tuesday, June 23rd, 2020**

Overview:

59 proposals received

57 Proposals accepted

2 Proposals declined

The proposals were of a high quality this year and acceptance rate was high.

CASEA was allotted 23 spaces in the program based on past attendance and on membership. Of those sessions, 3 of them were already dedicated to events that we agreed to hold during the conference:

- AGM and Luncheon
- Graduate Student session (in the preconference)
- T.B. Greenfield presentation

To ensure we continue to get a good number of spots in the program, it would be great to have an increase in proposals for the 2021 conference. We encourage members to put forward their proposals and encourage grad students are others in the area of Ed. Admin to join CASEA and put forward proposals for next year as well.

The Review Process

Thank you to those of you who completed your requested peer reviews. We had a strong showing by the membership around reviews this year and it was greatly appreciated. Many papers had at least one review completed by a member outside of the executive and a number had both reviews completed. This level of participation was very helpful to the VP's as we worked our way through the submissions, and we are hopeful to have a similar showing for the 2021 review process. The quality of most of the submissions was high and only a few were rejected. There were still some issues around authorship, however, and for the upcoming conference we would again remind member that authors can only be first author on one submission.

Roundtables

We had five proposals submitted round tables and two submitted as posters. These were accepted to this route. We did not have to put any accepted multi-paper submissions to the round table.

Symposia

We had 2 Symposia submissions, both of which were accepted. As per our request from last year, we received fewer symposia requests this year and that was helpful in ensuring representation and opportunity to present across a wide range of the membership.

Multi-paper Sessions

The number of individual papers submitted was a little lower than last year, but not a significant decline. We were able to work with this number within our allotted time slots and all acceptable papers were able to be accommodated.

Banquet & CASEA Book Launch

Although these events were cancelled this year, Pam spent a considerable amount of time working to secure venues and menus. We look forward to hosting these events again next year and ask that anyone who was planning to launch a book in 2020 submit to launch at the event in 2021.
