

## TENURE-TRACK POSITION – ASSISTANT PROFESSOR EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION

The Faculty of Education at the University of Regina is inviting applications for a Full-time, Tenure-Track Position appointment beginning July 1, 2019.

The Faculty of Education seeks an individual who can contribute to the Early Childhood Education (ECE) subject area and the Elementary Program. The Faculty has a strong orientation towards social justice in education and is committed to enacting the themes, vision, values and mission of the University's Strategic Plan - *peyak aski kikawinaw*: Together We Are Stronger. Consistent with this orientation, the ECE subject area supports students to engage critically with practices in Pre-K-5 educational settings. The ECE area works toward integrating Indigenous and decolonizing approaches to early learning and expanding inclusive practices for diverse populations of young children. The Faculty offers a four-year B.Ed., a two-year after degree B.Ed., and graduate degrees at the Master's and Doctoral levels. The ECE subject area has recently launched two certificate programs serving teachers, teacher candidates, early childhood educators, and individuals working with young children in the helping professions. These certificate programs are offered in face-to-face, online, and blended formats.

**Duties:** The individual will be responsible for teaching undergraduate classes in ECE as an integral part of the Elementary Pre-K-5 program, teaching across the Elementary Program, teaching at the graduate level in the ECE area, supervising undergraduate students in field experiences, supervising graduate students, assuming active involvement in Faculty endeavours and engaging in individual and collaborative scholarly research. The successful candidate will also be required to engage in collegial governance by serving on faculty and university committees while making contributions to the wider community.

**Qualifications:** The successful individual will possess, or be near the completion of, a Ph.D. degree with a focus in Early Childhood Education. The individual should demonstrate successful teaching experience in K-12 schools, preferably at the Pre-K-3 level, and university environments and have an active research agenda. The individual should have (or be eligible for) a valid Professional A (Saskatchewan) teaching certificate. The successful candidate must be both a self-starter and capable of working collaboratively and professionally in the realms of teaching, student supervision (both in the field and the classroom), research, governance, and community engagement.

**Salary Range:** Depending on qualifications and experience, normally in the Assistant Professor range (\$83,787 - \$106,571) as per the URFA Collective Agreement.
