

**Lecturer (2 Year Term)
Elementary Teacher Bachelor of Education Program**

The Faculty of Education is inviting applications for the position of Lecturer (2 Year Term) in the Elementary Teacher Bachelor of Education Program. The Faculty has a strong orientation towards social justice in education and is committed to enacting the themes, vision, values and mission of the University's Strategic Plan - *peyak aski kikawinaw*: Together We Are Stronger.

The Elementary Program is the largest teacher education program of the Faculty of Education at the University of Regina offering a four year B.Ed. and a two year after degree B.Ed. at the early (K-5) and middle years (6-8) levels. Graduates of our program seek employment in elementary schools across Saskatchewan and Canada.

Duties: The successful candidate will:

- teach undergraduate courses in teaching methods;
- assume active involvement in the Elementary Program group;
- supervise students during school practicum experiences;
- contribute to Faculty committees; and
- support the review and development of elementary program offerings

Teaching Responsibilities: Depending on specialization and experience, the candidate will teach a minimum of six classes per academic year in some or all of the following areas: core studies, social studies, and science for elementary levels.

Qualifications: The ideal candidate must have significant university teaching experience related to curriculum and instruction in the Elementary context. The candidate must have (or be eligible for) a valid Professional A (Saskatchewan) teaching certificate and have a strong dossier of teaching experience which includes work in the elementary context. The successful candidate must possess a relevant Master's degree, however a Ph.D. is preferred.

Salary Range: Depending on qualifications and experience, normally in the Lecturer range (\$67,693 - \$83,381) as per the URFA Collective Agreement.
