

Lecturer in Educational Psychology (Term)

The Faculty of Education at the University of Regina invites applications for a Lecturer in Educational Psychology for a one-year term appointment (with the possibility of extension) with an anticipated start date of July 1, 2020.

The Faculty of Education seeks an individual who can contribute to the Educational Psychology Program, with expertise in the areas of school psychology and counselling. The Faculty has a strong orientation towards social justice issues in education and is committed to enacting the themes, vision, values and mission of the University's Strategic Plan. Consistent with this orientation, the Educational Psychology area supports students to critically engage with counselling and psychoeducational assessment practices utilized in school and community contexts.

Duties: This is a teaching-focused position that has a 6 to 8 course per year teaching load. Courses to be taught will be determined according to the needs of the Faculty. The successful candidate will teach graduate classes in Educational Psychology including counselling and psychoeducational assessment; supervise Educational Psychology students in practicum experiences; and assume active involvement in the collegial governance of the Faculty.

Qualifications: The successful candidate must possess, at minimum, a Master's degree in Educational Psychology (or a strongly related field); however, a Ph.D. is preferred. The ideal candidate must have significant university teaching experience related to school psychology and counselling practices as well as relevant experience in psychoeducational assessment practices. Experience working with Indigenous populations and in indigenizing course content would be beneficial. The individual should be registered or should be eligible for registration with a provincial college of psychologists or equivalent.

Salary Range: Depending on qualifications and experience, normally in the Lecturer range (\$81,102 - \$101,070) as per URFA Collective Agreement.

- Cover letter that outlines qualifications, research and teaching interests
- Current curriculum vitae including the names and contact information of three references
- Statement of teaching philosophy
- Unofficial transcripts
