



## Lecturer in Science & Environmental Teacher Education (Term)

The Faculty of Education at the University of Regina invites applications for a Lecturer in Science and Environmental Teacher Education (Secondary and Elementary) for a one-year term appointment (with the possibility of extension) with an anticipated start date of July 1, 2020.

The Faculty of Education seeks an individual who can contribute to the Science and Environmental Education subject area with a focus on the principles and practices of social and ecological justice. The Faculty has a strong orientation towards social and environmental justice issues in education and is committed to enacting the themes, vision, values and mission of the University's Strategic Plan. Consistent with this orientation, the Science and Environmental Education subject area supports students to critically engage with science and environmental education practices in K-12 schools as well as in non-formal and informal education settings.

**Duties:** This is a teaching-focused position that has a 6 to 8 course per year teaching load. Courses to be taught will be determined according to the needs of the Faculty. The successful candidate will teach undergraduate methods courses in science and environmental education; engage with the Science and Environmental Education area colleagues as well as educational partners in ongoing program renewal; assume active involvement in the Secondary and Elementary Program groups; supervise students during school practicum experiences; assume active involvement in the collegial governance of the Faculty; and support the review and development of secondary and elementary program offerings.

**Qualifications:** The successful candidate must possess a relevant Master's degree; however, a Ph.D. is preferred. The ideal candidate must have significant university teaching experience related to curriculum and instruction in the secondary and elementary contexts. The candidate must have (or be eligible for) a valid Professional A (Saskatchewan) teaching certificate and have a strong dossier of teaching experience which includes work in the secondary and elementary contexts. Candidates should be ready to demonstrate a commitment to social and ecological justice, truth and reconciliation, and/or decolonizing work in education as part of their overall pedagogy.

**Salary Range:** Depending on qualifications and experience, normally in the Lecturer range (\$81,102 - \$101,070) as per URFA Collective Agreement.
