Tenure-Track Assistant Professor Minority Language Education (Francophone & Immersion Schools)

The Faculty of Education at the University of Regina is seeking to fill a tenure-track position at the rank of Assistant Professor in the area of minority language education – Francophone and immersion.

Our faculty's Programme du Baccalauréat (Bac) offers a variety of teacher education programs to those seeking future employment in French language schools, including French immersion, Francophone, and Core French programs. The faculty also offers a Maîtrise en éducation française. The faculty has a strong social justice orientation and is guided by the University's Strategic Plan University's Strategic Plan – *All Our Relations: kahkiyaw kiwâhkômâkaninawak*.

Duties: The successful candidate will:

- teach in French undergraduate courses in core studies and/or language and literacy methods in the context of immersion and of Francophone minority schooling
- supervise undergraduate students during school practicum experiences
- teach in the *Maîtrise en éducation française* and supervise graduate students
- contribute actively to the collegial governance of the Bac program and the Faculty of Education
- engage in research and scholarship

Qualifications: The successful candidate will possess or be near completion of an earned doctorate degree (Ph.D. or Ed.D.) with an academic focus on French language education and methods. The candidate must have (or be eligible for) a valid Professional A (Saskatchewan) teaching certificate and will have teaching experience in an immersion, Francophone or core French school setting. Bilingual, this person will have especially strong written and oral French skills while being able to demonstrate a working knowledge of written and spoken English. The candidate must also have an active research agenda and publication record related to French language education in Canada. In terms of professionalism, the person sought must be able to work both independently and collaboratively in a team setting.

Salary Range: Depending on qualifications and experience, normally in the Assistant Professor range (\$89,914 - \$113,562) as per URFA Collective Agreement.
