



**Lecturer (2-Year Term): Francophone and Immersion Education
In A Minority Language Context**

The *Baccalauréat en éducation* (Bac) Program of the Faculty of Education at the University of Regina is seeking applicants for the position of Lecturer in the area of minority language education – Francophone and immersion schools.

Our faculty's Programme du Baccalauréat offers a variety of teacher education programs to those seeking future employment in French language schools, including French immersion, Francophone, and Core French programs. The faculty has a strong social justice orientation and is guided by the University's Strategic Plan University's Strategic Plan – *All Our Relations: kahkiyaw kiwâhkômâkaninawak*.

Duties: The successful candidate will teach undergraduate courses in teaching methods in French; assume active involvement in the Bac Program group; supervise students during school practicum experiences; contribute to Faculty committees; and support the development of students' oral and written French skills.

Teaching Responsibilities: Depending on specialization and experience, the candidate will teach a minimum of six classes in some or all of the following areas: assessment and evaluation, inclusive education, student development, health education, physical education, Core Studies, mathematics, and French language and literacy (reading and writing), for elementary, middle years or secondary levels.

Qualifications: The ideal candidate will have university teaching experience related to curriculum and instruction in minority language education contexts (including Francophone and French immersion). The candidate will have a solid mastery of both oral and written French and have at least a working knowledge of written and spoken English. The candidate must have (or be eligible for) a valid Professional A (Saskatchewan) teaching certificate and have a strong dossier of teaching experience which includes work at the elementary and or secondary level in Francophone minority or French immersion contexts. While it is preferred that the successful candidate possess a relevant Master's degree or PhD, a Bachelor's degree supplemented by significant teaching experience will also be considered.

Salary Range: Depending on qualifications and experience, normally in the Lecturer range (\$81,102 - \$101,070) as per URFA Collective Agreement.

Starting Date: July 1, 2022 (two-year term with the possibility of extension)
